

SLOAC Meeting Minutes  
9.30.19

Attendance: Cara, Nancy, Farhad, Yashica, Logan (via phone)

1. Review of Minutes & Approval - unanimous
2. Updates/Issues
  - a. Check-in regarding how has everything been going based on the assessment schedules. Everything has been built and will be awaiting Health Sciences (awaiting confirmation from a faculty member and will be meeting soon), Life & Earth (most are stage 4 & 5 of the approval process), ECE and Social Sciences
  - b. Math is continuing to use a shared assessment tool, where equivalent questions are used on the final exams to assess student progress
3. ISLOs
  - a. Last meeting, Cara shared the GE and ISLO. The first 4 is what we have already had historically: communication, information literacy, critical thinking, and scientific and quantitative reasoning.
  - b. As a committee a couple of years ago, reviewed assessment from other colleges who included civic responsibility and cultural awareness and personal and professional development
  - c. Determined that we would keep the GE and ISLOs the same
  - d. Sent to areas to see how they linked with the ISLOs. Feedback and changes made to the language so that they fit together in an effective way.
  - e. We will hold a community hour session to see if anyone want to weigh in on the finalized version. Once we receive feedback, we can sent to Academic Senate and map individual course outcomes to at least one ISLOs.
  - f. Will create a newsletter that offers an opportunity to review the recommended proposed revised ISLO. The two news ISLOs will be featured as additions and reflects the complete mission of the College. Yashica will create the newsletter for everyone to review and provide input
4. PSLOs
  - a. Cara shared the PSLO mapping tool. We need to map our degree and certificates, ideally by this fall although the spring is more realistic. This will provide an opportunity for departments to revise or keep their PSLOs. If revised this fall, we can map in the spring. If revised in the spring, then mapping will take place in fall 2020. The accreditation midterm report is due in the spring 2021. Goal is to get a couple of degrees mapped this semester.
  - b. Need to review the program outline of record.
  - c. Department coordinator, SLO & Assessments, select PSLOs, Curriculum Map, select individual program.
  - d. Cara will confirm if these are all the classes to ensure that we are approaching it correctly.
  - e. Review the program outcomes with the “owners” of the degree programs. Will decide to provide a printout of the page so that faculty can identify the areas of support.
