Program Mapping Instructions

- 1. To map in eLumen you will need to be in your Department Coordinator role.
- 2. You can log in at <u>marin.elumenapp.com</u> or go to <u>marin.edu</u> and log into your mycom account. You will see eLumen in the menu on the left. As a reminder, for best results, you should use to use Chrome or Firefox to login to eLumen.
- 3. When you log in, check the role to the right of your name. If your screen defaults to the faculty role, change your role to Department Coordinator at the top as seen in the screenshot below. To the right of your name you will see the department for which you are department chair.
