Accreditation Update

There are <u>several ACCJC recommendations</u> about SLOs that the college must respond to in the next 3 years:

- By October 2018, we must show significant progress toward addressing inconsistencies between SLOs on the official Course Outline of Record and how they read on some syllabi. The College must also make program-level SLOs available to students.
- By March 2021, we must show resolution of the following:
 - o The assessment of course level student learning outcomes should be more clearly identified, and evidence or results of those assessments should be gathered in a way that enables the College to disaggregate the data by subpopulations.
 - Banner talks to it
 - Demographics.
 - English 150? -- and then we can. SLO Performance

- o In order to improve institutional effectiveness, the College should consider reducing the number of general education student learning outcomes to a sustainable level **and ensure that all programs are completing assessments.**
 - Programs degrees/certificates (what about disciplines that don't have a degree/certificate)? NESL is in progress
 - DART will work on it (will look at programs that are not degree/certificate terminal programs that aren't connected maybe need to be rethought
 - FA can be used as an example; Business
 - What about CSLOs not being assessed? Use carrot. Talk about successes?
- o In order to improve institutional effectiveness, when using outcome assessment data, the institution should consider strengthening the link between assessment and improving learning for all of its student populations.
 - Program Review
