Disaggregated data: Holley needs to know how to access the raw data and whether fee is for each time or one-time. We are still missing race/ethnicity data (and these appear at times separately). Cari and Logan will organize w/ Holley to meet w/ Megan to see next steps for missing data and how to access raw data. Canvas: We tested push out of outcomes into Canvas. Some error messages but some got pushed out. Overall group decided to move ahead with exploring this collegewide

	 Things we need to troubleshoot (Logan and Cara will start looking into this): Outcomes are editable – Can Stacey lock this? Can they be imported into syllabus? They appear to be assessable for everyone but only those set up for assessment will actually gather the data in eLUMEN, which is an issue if we want to try this collegewide. Canvas timing – can they be exported into unpublished Canvas course and before eLUMEN switches to next semester? Timing to alert faculty of this – B.Lee might create a video we could send out over summer.
ISLO Data: First look at aggregated and disaggregated ISLO data. http://slo.marin.edu/college-wide	 Only use aggregated at this point – do not use disaggregated since there's some data missing. Caveats with ISLO data – may be skewed toward full time students since they are likely to be assessed more than part time students in this data. These eLUMEN reports are not very readable – can eLUMEN add short cut names to ISLOs or column totals to make these more readable? Ultimately for these to be more readable we need Tableau. We will look at how CCSF uses their ISLO data, but some ideas include GE Committee and Board for mission review. Why is outcomes data much higher than institution set standard?
