

SLOs in eLUMEN

To check SLOs in eLUMEN faculty will need to sign in eLUMEN at marin.elumenapp.com.

1. Open up a web browser and go to **marin.elumenapp.com** (note that the eLUMEN web URL ends in **.com** not **.edu**)
2. The MyCom login screen will appear.
3. Sign in with your MyCom username and password

The landing page for faculty will have your courses listed below. Make sure you see faculty after your name and your department listed next to the faculty tab.
