SLO Symposium Takeaways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- SLO assessment in context of Guided Pathways (Badges, eLUMEN and student-facing component). Connect to 4<sup>th</sup> pillar, equity, and assessment</li> <li>- eLUMEN student component: When students can view badges, makes it student-centered and public-facing brings added intention to creating SLOs.</li> <li>- SLO assessment is happening stand-alone in Canvas</li> <li>- Program Pathways Mapper can integrate w/ eLUMEN</li> <li>- Map SLOs to badges and embed in pathways</li> <li>- Know your WHY: WHY are we doing this? ACCJC not good answer. Student learning and equity – Assessment leaders need to be able to be able to coherently describe <b>why assessment makes learning better. Technology is only the tool, not the answer.</b></li> <li>- Value of assessment:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SLOs for alignment;</li> <li>SLOs for norming (keeps grading from being subjective)</li> </ul> </li> <li>- Students -where are they in this practice?</li> <li>- Rebranding assessment as Teaching and Learning (Los Medanos – Jill, Scott, Briana)</li> <li>- Coordinate PD related to assessment and pedagogy               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-support assessment effort</li> <li>-more demand for intensive prof dev</li> <li>-Offer PD training that incorporates SLO assessment data, not specifically</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>about SLO data</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Backwards design training to make SLOs meaningful (Jay McTighe)</li> <li>- SLOs: Faculty set the metrics for how to measure instruction in their own classrooms</li> <li>- Value of assessment: SLOs for alignment; SLOs for norming (keeps grading from being subjective)</li> <li>-ISLO assessments: Maps will show what’s aligned; it doesn’t show us which level are introductory, etc.</li> </ul> <p>-How show progress of SLO development --- how do courses do this? At the institution level</p> <p>COM: WHAT ARE YOUR WHYS? Depends on department</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Accreditation</li> <li>- Sciences –</li> <li>- Degree / Certificate – if we can’t do it, then how can the student</li> <li>- More time is needed to gather sufficient meaningful SLO data, so in the meantime alignment</li> <li>- Backwards design</li> <li>- How to dig in further?</li> <li>- CC – when course is renewed or new, do mapping? (Gina / Cari. Cara will send out Wed. dates. Nancy will look into it)</li> <li>- Canvas useage – what % are we at use-age?</li> </ul>
