GETTING IT DONE - HIGHLIGHTS FROM DEPARTMENTS

As you work on developing your assessment plans, check out these strategies from other departments:

The Math Department assesses all course Student Learning Outcomes (CSLOs) in all classes every Spring. We have a shared list of questions that instructors include in an exam (usually a final exam). For each CSLO, we have three variants (A, B, and C) of a question that we rotate from year to year. In Spring 2019, everyone will use “A” questions, next spring we will use “B” questions, etc. At the end of the semester, each faculty will turn the scores on these CSLO questions into one of the five levels of achievement to be reported in eLumen.
